# LEGISLATIVE PRIORITIES

The following were selected as priorities by the NMC Board of Directors for the 2019 session:

## **Behavioral Health**

Authorize HSD to provide behavioral health services to adults and juveniles who have behavioral health diagnoses and who are housed in county detention centers.

## **Fire Protection Fund**

Remove the State Fire Marshal's Office and Fire Protection Fund from the PRC to improve advocacy and communication and fund protection and carryover for operations and major purchases.

## **HB2 Appropriations**

- Detention Reimbursement Fund—Restore to the original appropriation of \$5 million.
- Prisoner Transport & Extradition—Create a line item in the DFA budget with \$750,000 to reimburse counties that provide transportation for state prisoners.
- EMS Funding—Appropriate \$5 million annually to the EMS Fund and identify a designated revenue mechanism for growth and stability.

## **Tax Reform**

Support efforts that improve economic efficiency, economic development, ease of administration, and ensure fairness of the tax system. NMC to be included in restructure and reform efforts of the state and local tax system (seat at the table).

## **Forfeiture Act Reform**

Address unintended consequences of the 2015 amendments to the NM Forfeiture Act. Fix the confusion around abandoned property; provide for reimbursement to local law enforcement agencies; extend due process protections to local DWI vehicle seizures; and exclude limited equitable sharing provisions contained in the 2017 & 2018 bills.

It is a program designed to provide a comprehensive course of study to administrators, managers, elected officials, and staff in local, state, tribal, and national government, through which participants can acquire and apply the best practices and theory to their management behaviors and strategies using the highest professional standards.

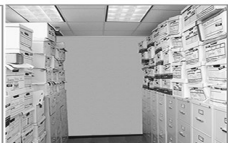
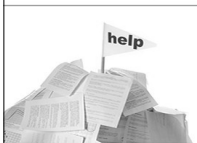
