2019 BUILD Grants Notice of Funding

The Better Utilizing Investments to Leverage Development, or "<u>BUILD Transportation grants</u> has opened.

Total funding is \$900 million.

Eligible Applicants: are States, local and tribal governments

Grant awards are split 50/50 between rural and urban areas. Grants awarded on a competitive basis for projects that will have a significant local or regional impact. Grants may not be less than \$5 million nor greater than \$25 million, except for projects located in rural areas the minimum grant size is \$1 million.

Deadline: July 15, 2019 at 6:00 p.m. MDT
