



Did you know?

Income cap for seniors or disabled for property tax benefit increases from \$32,000 to \$35,000, going into effect for tax year 2020. The value freeze is for a single-family dwelling occupied by a person who is 65 years of age or older or disabled, and whose modified gross income for the prior taxable year did not exceed \$35,000.
