The Bureau of Justice Assistance is seeking applications for the Rural Responses to the Opioid Epidemic Grant. This grant program is designed to build local capacity, foster crosssector collaboration and support innovation. Up to eight rural communities or regions that are impacted by the opioid epidemic will be selected for grant awards up to \$750,000 each for a 24-month period. Applications are due **July 26**.
