### **2020 Census Complete Count Grant Funding**

DFA has sent out county-optional grant agreements to ALL counties! Submit your 1) county resolution, 2) intergovernmental grant agreement and 3) outreach plan to DFA by September 27, 2019 for funding on October 11, 2019. Did you know?

- Each New Mexican not counted is a loss of ~\$3,745 in funding/year
- If NM undercounts residents by 1%, we lose ~\$780 million in the next 10 years
- NM is considered the hardest to count state in the nation
