- Keep calm, breathe
- Shift your emotion
- Practice fire drills
- Takes 2 sleeps for an officer to remember an incident

A.D.D. — Avoid Deny Deffend

Avoid = Run

Deny = Hide (if can't get out; lock door, barricade)

Defend = Fight (survival mindset)
