- Know your exits, not just the entrance
- Keep calm, breathe
- Shift your emotion Practice fire drills
- Takes 2 sleeps for an officer to remember an incident

A.D.D.—Avoid Deny Deffend

Deny = Hide (if can't get out; lock door, barricade) <u>Defend = Fight (survival mindset)</u>
