An update from New Mexico Counties Executive Director Steve

Kopelman: The COVID-19 pandemic continues to wreak havoc and destruction. We are hoping the number of cases will peak shortly and that there will be light at the end of this very dark tunnel. The New Mexico Counties Executive Committee met telephonically last Friday and voted to cancel the June annual conference in Doña Ana County. On Tuesday the New Mexico Supreme Court will hear oral arguments (and hopefully render a decision) on the petition filed by 26 county clerks to have the upcoming primaries be substantially an all-

mail in election. The state Republican party has intervened and is opposing the petition. Finally, we are pleased to announce a federal court decision in a multicounty case that Brandon Huss and the New Mexico Counties legal bureau have been defending on behalf of several county sheriffs regarding registration of sex offenders. Judge Parker agreed with both arguments we raised in our motion to dismiss and the claims brought against sheriffs represented by the legal bureau have been dismissed. This decision provides important support for arguments we have been pursuing in relation to individual liability of county elected officials for official capacity claims. The bottom line: this was a big victory for county government!
