An update from New Mexico Counties Executive Director Steve Kopelman

The good news is that statewide cases of COVID-19 are leveling out, and that evidence of community spread is limited to seven New Mexico counties. The Governor has indicated that she will extend through May 15 the stay at home order and other restrictions already in place. The bad news is that the proliferation of new cases in McKinley and San Juan Counties continues, and the death toll in New Mexico is up to 71. Numerous rural counties have passed resolutions asking the Governor to consider reopening businesses in their counties with appropriate safeguards in place. The Governor announced the creation of an Economic Recovery Task Force, and NMC legislative team leader and grocery store owner Brian Moore has been appointed co-chair. The first Task Force meeting is scheduled for tomorrow morning. A loud shout out and our thanks and appreciation go to our first responders, who are doing amazing work in the face of huge adversity and danger. County law enforcement, fire and emergency personnel, and detention officers are truly heroes and are doing fantastic jobs!

Senate Passes \$484 Billion COVID-19 Relief

Consensus Revenue Estimating Group (CREG) is currently working on updating and running models for GRT estimates and will share next week.

Governor Lujan Grisham expects to extend the public health order restricting many business operations until May 15. She has formed an Economic Recovery Council composed of 15 businesses and a bipartisan group of mayors to work on a plan for reopening. It would be phased opening of the economy: first phase would include some non-essential businesses to re-open; second phase would allow additional businesses to re-open however, large gatherings and events would be restricted.


