New Mexico Finance Authority Offers Emergency Loans. Funding for both for-profit and non-profit covering operational expenses, up to \$1 M, based upon borrowing capacity, term loans up to five years, lines of credit up to one year, and with interest rates at 1%. Eligible are rural hospitals, behavioral health providers, and substance abuse providers to name a few. Apply now and get the FAQs at www.NMFA.net.

NMC 2020 Final Legislative Report now available. The 2020 30-day legislative session is in our rear view mirror, and we are getting ready for a June 18 special session to trim the general fund budget that the Legislature approved just a short three and a half months ago. Since then, the COVID-19 pandemic has swept the nation and virtually shut down New Mexico's businesses, resulting in a drastic reduction in the collection of gross receipts taxes, and the price of oil has plummeted. At the special session, the Legislature will have to dip into the State reserves and come up with numerous budget cuts in order to balance the FY2021 budget.
