**Special Session Summary Update** Of the seven bills passed, five bills have been signed by the Governor as of COB Wednesday:

HB1 General Appropriation Act Sanding

HB 5 Establishes a bipartisan nine-member NM Civil Rights Commission

HB 6 Temporarily waives interest & penalty on late tax payments; doubles state GRT distributions from online sales to local governments for FY 21

SB 4 Allows county clerks to automatically mail applications for absentee ballotsc to mitigate the potential impact of COVID-19 pandemic on the 2020 general election in November

**SB 5** Reverts unencumbered state appropriations, capital outlay projects for severance tax bond; cancels some capital outlay projects; "sweeps" \$1M from LDWI Fund, \$2M from Enhanced E911 Fund The Governor has **until July 12, 2020** to take action on the rest of the bills; Effective date is September 20 if not a general appropriation or a bill carrying an emergency clause or other specified date.
