# The Pandemic Has Permanently Changed the Way We Work

A report finds that the coronavirus-caused shift to remote work has altered the idea of a workspace. Some are uncomfortable with returning to an office and many hope to continue working from home even after offices reopen. A recent study found several key findings:

- 70% say working remotely outweighs the disadvantages, citing increased time and comfort when working from home
- Would like to work from home at least once or twice weekly
- 80% would not feel comfortable returning to their office space before a COVID-19 vaccine was available
- Three quarters say remote working has blurred the differentiation between work and personal life
- Half reported an increase in feelings of isolation and loneliness
- 32% disagreed that they were more productive while working remotely
- 31% believe virtual meetings are less effective than in-person

# COVID-19 Continues to Discourage

**Payments with Cash** (~Governing.com) As shoppers stay home and the CDC encourages the use of touchless transactions, the amount of cashless payments has seen a steady increase. About 78% of purchases are now paid through credit/debit cards. Cash withdrawals from ATMs plunged 25% nationwide in March with 27% of businesses reporting an increase in contactless payments. Banks have been slowly closing branches/ ATMs, nudging us more to digital platforms. The declining market share of cash as a payment medium may be propelled by a younger generation paying for everything with digital wallets on smart phones or watches.
