

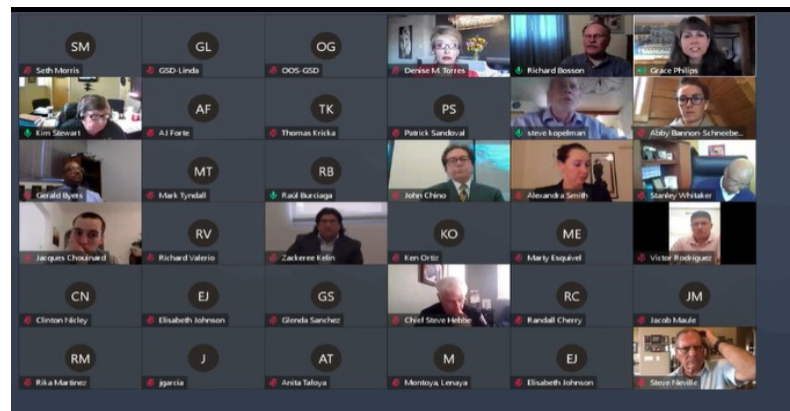


## Sandoval County Receives Adult Misdemeanor Compliance Program Reaccreditation

The Adult Misdemeanor Compliance Accreditation Professional Standards Council awarded Sandoval County a three-year Certificate of Reaccreditation during the County commission meeting on October 1, 2020. NMC states concerns w/devastating fiscal impact to state, counties, cities, schools regarding HB5:

- New cause of action w/no caps; possibly punitive damages
- Award of plaintiff attorney fees
- No qualified immunity as a defense
- An extended three-year statute of limitation
- Fiscal impact on counties without law enforcement reinsurance coverage

### NMC Board Actions 10.01.20—10.02.20

**Priority:** County Government—NMC opposes unfunded mandates imposed on county government and opposes legislation that has a significant negative impact on revenue, budgets, and liabilities.

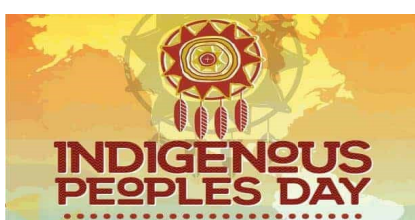
Classes are live online

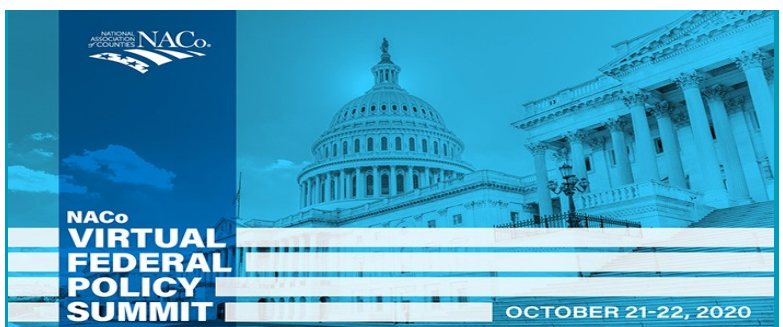
