## NMCIA Board Renews ML and LE Reinsurance, Approves 2021 Member Contributions

The New Mexico County Insurance Authority Board of Directors voted on October 28 to approve renewal pricing for its liability reinsurance and member contributions for policy year 2021. Overall, the multi-line reinsurance received a flat renewal with the same coverage limits. The law enforcement reinsurance coverage increased by 41%.

Most county members will receive a small reduction or flat renewal in their multi-line contributions. While there was a substantial law enforcement reinsurance increase over last year, seven member counties (Catron, Doña Ana, Harding, McKinley, Mora, Quay, Torrance) will receive a 20% contribution decrease (off the 2021 contribution) to reward them for exemplary claims experience over the last 10 years. All other counties, except one, will receive a small reduction or flat renewal.

## <u>CDC revises guidance defining COVID-</u> <u>19 exposure</u>

A "close contact" is now someone who was within six feet of an infected person for a cumulative total of 15 minutes or more over a 24-hour period, beginning two days before illness onset. This new guidance has significant implications for counties as they work to ensure the health and safety of justiceinvolved individuals and correctional staff during this public health emergency.
