NMC Legislative Priority

**NMC opposes unfunded** mandates imposed on county government and opposes legislation that has a significant negative impact on revenue, budgets, and liabilities.



### **Revisions to SB 8 - Law Enforcement Body Cameras.**

SB 8 provided no money to cover the costs of data storage or the labor to review, redact and produce video for IPRA requests.

SB 8 also doesn't account for the privacy and safety implications of the requirement that ALL interactions be recorded.



Revise New Mexico Statutes to put counties on the same footing as municipalities and school districts in the statutes on the disposition of property.



Allow Non-Profits to Secure Capital Outlay Funding Directly from State – Non-Profits, Anti-Donation, and Capital Outlay.



Revisions to the Solar Energy Improvement Special Assessment Act – Keeping it for commercial property, and excluding residential property



## NMC Opposes:

Creating a new civil rights cause of action, with unlimited damages and attorney fees.

NMC opposes legislation that would create a new special valuation class and property taxes for leased solar improvements on residential property.
