- Funded in 3 rounds—1st Round \$40M open for rural areas, 2nd round \$35M open Tues. Dec. 15, and 3rd round **\$25M** open Tues. Dec. 22
- 2019 Federal tax return, or 2018 along with extension
- Copy of authorized officer's &/or owner's valid NM driver's license (photo front/back)
- Copy of cancelled /voided check (photo front/ back)
- Proof of # of employees—determines amount
