

News Brief

February 18, 2021



HB 4 heads to the Senate after passing the House 39-29. All the Republicans voted no along with 5 Democrats (Castellano, Herrera, Lente, Madrid & Sweetser). The bill was assigned to two committees: Senate Health and Public Affairs and Senate Judiciary Committees. We are also following SB 376, besides hundreds of bills, which would make changes to the state Tort Claims Act and prohibit the use of qualified immunity in some instances.

February 18—Today deadline for bill introduction

March 20—Session ends (noon)

April 9—Legislation not acted upon by governor is pocket vetoed

June 18—Effective date of legislation not a general appropriation bill or a bill carrying an emergency clause or other specified date

September or October 2021 -- Special Session for Redistricting
