One-year Anniversary of Virus Pandemic

EMERGENCY BROADBAND BENEFIT

PROGRAM FCC is appropriated \$3.2 billion to provide subsidies through Internet Service Providers (ISPs) to low-income families for internet service. Eligible households may receive a discount of up to \$50, or \$75 on Tribal lands, off internet services and a subsidy for low-cost devices such as laptops. Households that qualify include those with children that qualify for free/reduced lunch, Pell grant recipients, recently unemployed or furloughed workers, an individual who qualifies for the FCC's Lifeline Program, or who qualifies for a low-income COVID-19 internet discount program.
