NMC Officer Elections Elections for NMC President Elect, Vice President, one NACo vacancy, and one WIR vacancy are scheduled for the Board meeting on **June 17, 2021**. Interested candidates must be nominated by another county elected official. The elected official making the nomination must complete the <u>Candidate Nomination Form</u> and return to Clarissa at <u>cbaca@nmcounties.org</u> by

5PM Friday, May 28, 2021 to be eligible. Candidates will have an opportunity to make a three minute presentation to the Board at the June meeting. Officer Duties: The President presides over all board and executive committee meetings, and other duties as incumbent upon the office. The president has authority to form special committees and assign other officers specific areas of responsibility. The president elect serves a one-year term and then automatically advances to the presidency. The vice president also serves a one-year term and then could run for president elect.
