Please welcome new manager Lucia Sánchez. She spent her last four years as the bureau chief for the NM Interstate Stream Commission at the OSE.

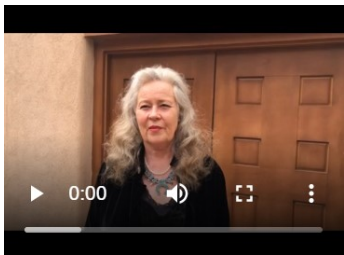
Lucia was the former county Planning and Zoning director and ran the DWI program. Communication is key for her as she is making the rounds to listen to her new employees.
