#### MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS (Share overview HERE)

- •Businesses or nonprofits must operate in New Mexico
- •Businesses or nonprofits must have at least one full-time or part-time employee but fewer than 75
- •Businesses or nonprofits had to lay off employees or reduce employee hours due to the pandemic
- •Businesses or nonprofits must be current on all state & local tax obligations
- •Businesses or nonprofits must have experienced a decline in business revenue between comparable quarters in taxable years 2019 and 2020

## **NMCIA Board Action Items November 4, 2021**

- Approved 2022 Law Enforcement program contributions; 4.7% increase from 2021 that factored in a 5% decrease for loss trends and a 12% increase to consider NM Civil Rights Act claims exposure
- Approved 2022 Multi-Line program contributions, a program-wide 5% decrease with members seeing a 3-7% reduction in contributions
- Tabled the 2022 budget; staff to provide additional details at December 8 meeting
- Approved the captive insurance company's state of domicile (Utah), board of directors: former NMCIA board chair Ron Lethgo, Utah Counties Indemnity Pool CEO Johnnie Miller (fulfilling the state residency requirement), NMC Executive Director Steve Kopelman, NMCIA board members Shirley Ragin and Jim Fambro, and entity name: New Mexico County Reinsurance Inc.
- Approved 2022 Multi-Line and Law Enforcement coverage agreement with minor changes
- Approved the revised Detention Officer Background Checks Policy to be included in the Pool's policy manual
- Approved 2022 NMC events calendar.
