Program Requirements



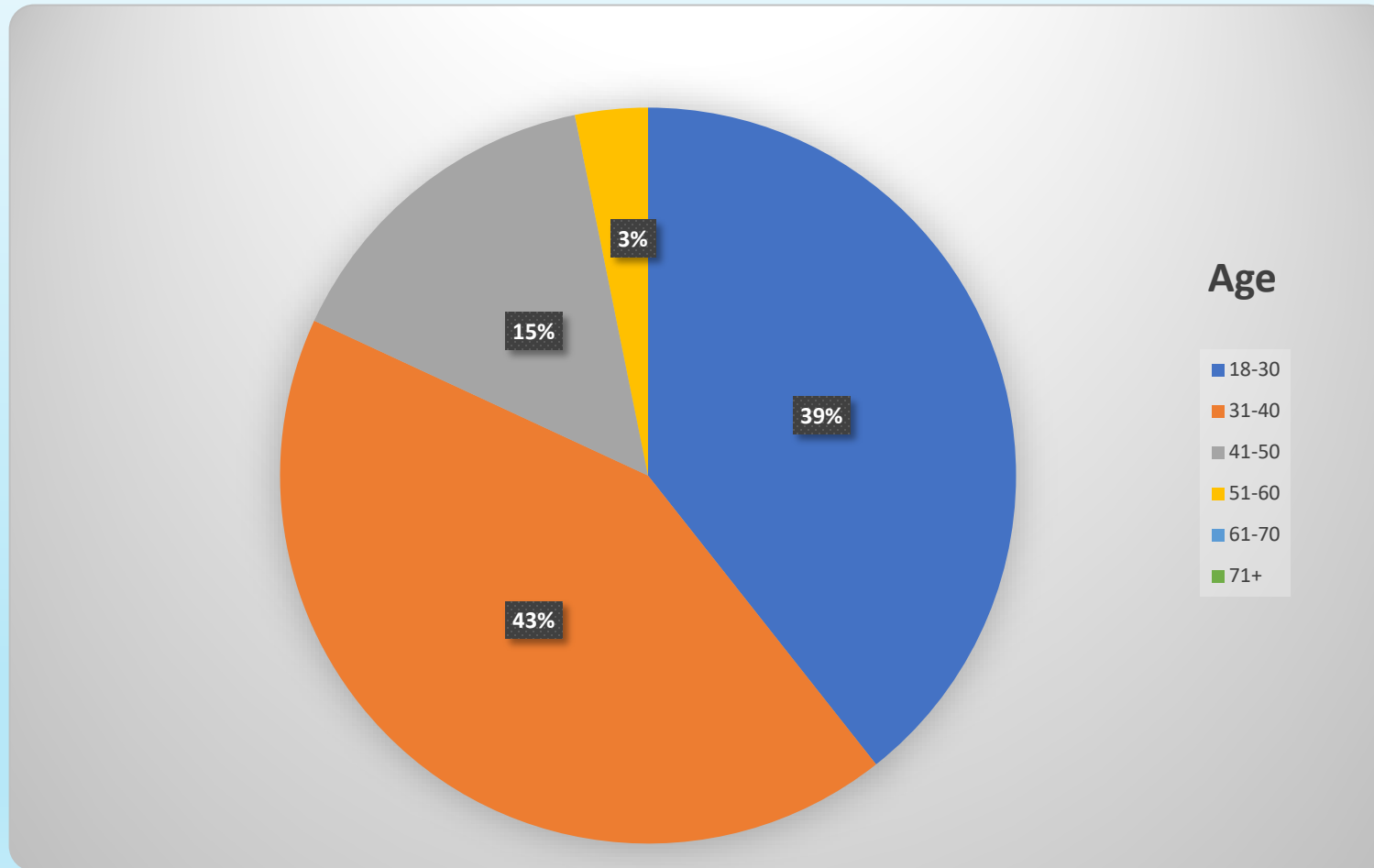
- Four offenses or more within a year
- Cannot be sentenced to DOC or have out-of-county or out-of-state charges
- Must be sentenced or in our facility for 30 days
- Usually District or Magistrate cases (Municipal cases are considered if sentenced to minimum of 30 days)

Provided Services

- Instant connection to in-house team
 - Transitional Navigator
 - Case Manager
 - Behavioral and Mental Health Professionals
- GED study material, Life Skills work sheets
- Weekly one-on-one sessions with Provider
- MCO connections to include monthly check in calls
- Coordination and connections to services upon release
- Case Management follow-up

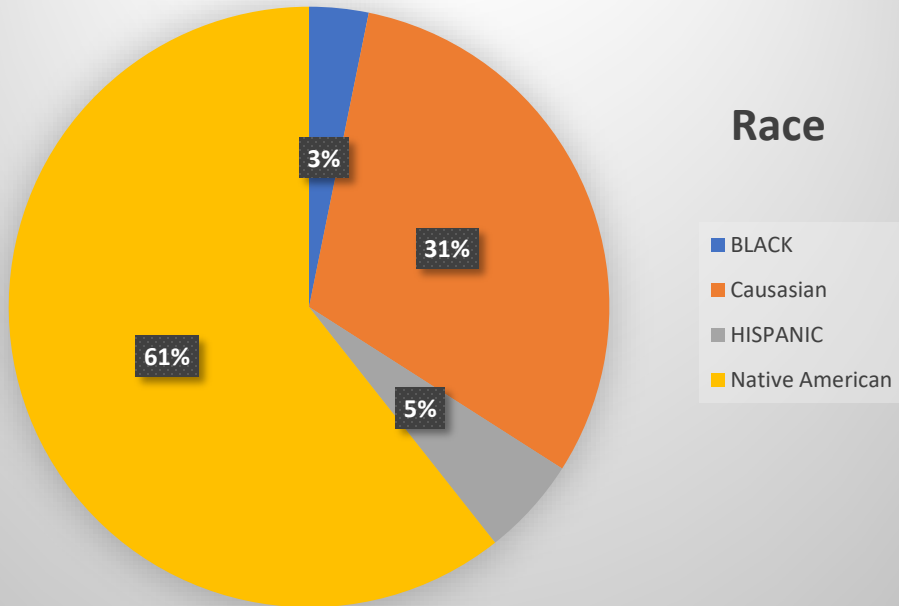


R.I.S.E. Demographics

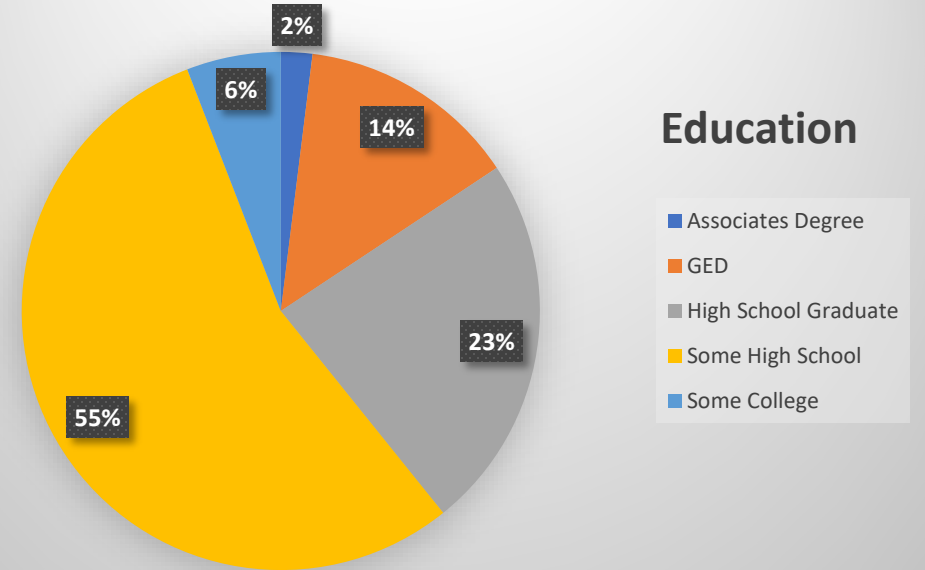


R.I.S.E. Demographics

Race



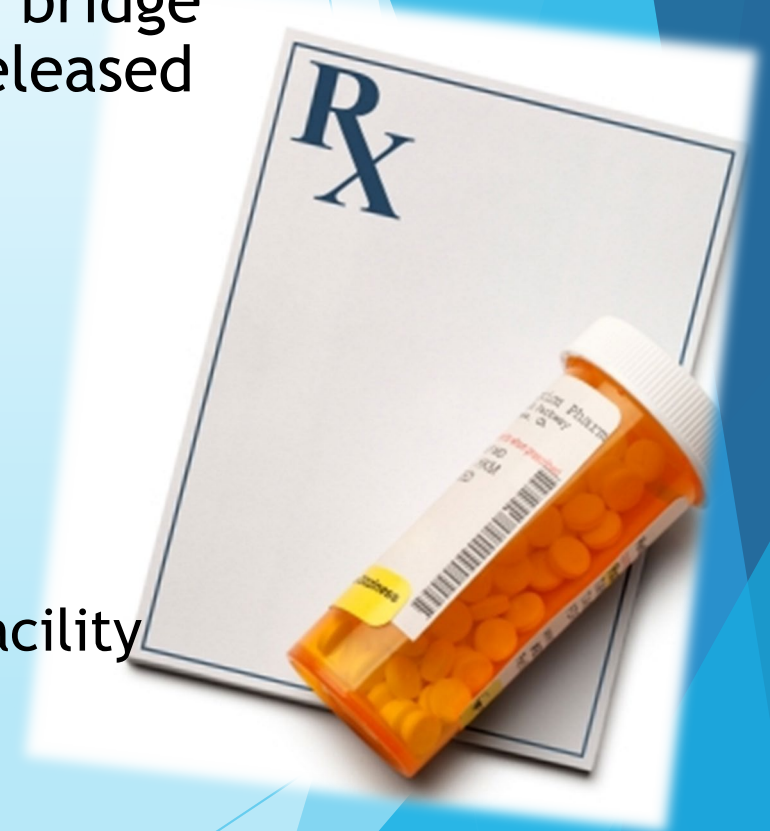

Prescription Pilot Program

R.I.S.E. Prescription Pilot Program was developed to bridge the gap and continuity of care when a detainee is released and pending services in the community.

- Mental health and maintenance medication are provided to:
 - All R.I.S.E. participants regardless of release type
 - Any detainee transported directly into a treatment facility
