NM Broadband Collective Equity Fund Managed by NM Foundation, is now accepting applications. The fund awards grants up to \$75,000 to

The <u>Collective</u> was formed to support a statewide approach to ensuring broadband services for all New Mexicans, especially in rural communities or hard-to-connect communities impacted by the lack of sustainable digital equity and affordable broadband solutions.

The Clean Water State Revolving Loan Fund (CWSRF) is lowering the interest

rate to 0.01% for all public entities that do not qualify for 0%. The CWSRF provides low interest loans for eligible wastewater, sewer collection, storm water and other water quality projects. Three bills were introduced and passed: HB 1 Special Session Legislative Expenses HB 2 Supplemental 2021 Income Tax Rebate and Relief Payments—To provide tax rebates of \$500 per person in two payments to help families offset the high gas prices SB1 (SB 48) Appropriations for State Agencies "Junior Bill" - appropriating \$51.2M The session was fast and furious.
