#### **Counties Required To Submit ARPA** Reporting on April 30<sup>th</sup>

All counties will be required to submit a American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) State and Local Fiscal Recovery Fund (SLFRF) report on April 30th even if you have not yet made expenditures. **USDA Forest Service Distributes FY 2021 SRS Payments to National Forest Counties** 

The \$238 million for Secure Rural Schools FY 2021 funding will provide critical funding for 742 U.S. counties and schools in 41 states and Puerto Rico through the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law

The bipartisan Infrastructure bill includes a 3-year, FY 2021, FY 2022, FY2023, extension of the Secure Rural Schools and Community Self-Determination Act (SRS). SRS is authorized and funded for FY 2021, 2022, and 2023. The infrastructure bill, P.L. 117-58, provides that for Fiscal Year 2021 and each fiscal year thereafter the amount is equal to the full funding amount of FY 2017. Five percent reductions are not continued. The bill's SRS provisions also includes regional pilots for Montana and Arizona.

Robust middle mile infrastructure will help foster universal broadband access to all unserved and underserved communities across NM by expediting the deployment and upgrades of last-mile broadband networks currently lacking affordable, high-capacity middle mile facilities.
