


News Brief

May 12, 2022



Wildfires have been increasing. In 2015, 2017, and 2020, more than 10 million acres burned nationwide. As county leaders across the nation grapple with wildfire risk and impact, expert practitioners and local leaders developed a variety of tools and strategies to help mitigate wildfire impacts on lives, property, and communities. These approaches are best executed at the local level as counties are uniquely positioned to mitigate wildfire through effective land use planning, land management, and community engagement. A few key terms to understand:

Wildland Fire: Any non-structure fire that occurs in vegetation and any wildfires and prescribed burns.

- natural fuels, including wildfires and prescribed burns.

 Wildfire: Any unplanned wildland fire that results in negative impact to human values, such as
- life, structures, and infrastructure

 Wildland-Urban Interface (WUI): Pronounced woo-eee; geographic area where natural environment intermixes with built environment, igniting/spreading fire. HERE for toolbox
