

## **County Members: Are You Covered?**



Please be aware that if your county gets its property insurance through the NMCIA Pool, you have coverage for flood damage in most cases. Additionally, (and perhaps important due to wildfires), the definition of Flood in the property policy states: "A. 3.) Mudslide or mud flow caused by accumulation of water on or under the ground." The intensity of some summer thunderstorms over the past few years has resuulted in claims of this variety. If you have questions, please contact NMC's Risk Management Department.

#### **Landowners & Acequias Affected by Fires**

Landowners who were affected by the recent Hermits Peak and Calf Canyon wildfires in San Miguel and Mora counties can apply for the NRCS Emergency Watershed Program (EWP). The program will cover 90% of the cost of post-fire mitigation measures that can protect life and property. The SWCD will cover the 10% match. The landowner can contribute in-kind materials and labor toward the 10% match. Examples of EWP mitigation measures include erosion control through contour felling, debris removal, retention ponds, berms, etc. Apply for <u>Tierra</u> <u>y Montes SWCD and Western Mora SWCD.</u>
