It supports community priorities for federal funding for nonprofits, public institutions, state, local, and Tribal governments. Deadline for the Preliminary Interest Form is **Tue Feb 28, 2023**. This is not the final funding request form.

Projects cannot be designated for private individuals or for-profit entities. Please note that eligibility requirements are subject to change from year to year, and final Senate Appropriations Committee guidance for FY 2024 is not yet available.

Doña Ana County Crisis Triage Center In partnership with RI International, Doña Ana County expanded its mobile crisis response service and integrated 988, the nationwide suicide and crisis line. It will assign call takers to dispatch its mobile crisis teams where needed. Mobile crisis response is an on-demand crisis intervention service that is available 24/7 to serve those individuals who are in distress. This is the first county in NM to have all three Crisis Now Model components implemented:
