USDA Makes Grants Available to Help People in Rural New Mexico to Repair Their Homes Damaged By Forest Fires in 2022

USDA has grants available to help people repair their homes that were damaged by the forest fires in 2022. The homes must be located in presidentially declared disaster areas: Colfax, Mora, and San Miguel Counties. The grants are available through supplemental disaster funding under the **Rural Disaster Home Repair Grant Program**. People may apply to receive grants of up to \$40,675 directly from USDA to repair their homes. Funds available until expended and may be used to:

- Pay for home repair expenses that were a result of a Presidentially declared disaster in 2022
- Prepare a site for a manufactured home
- Relocate a manufactured home

Eligibility: Household incomes that don't exceed low-limits; homes in an eligible rural area Learn more **HERE**
