NMCIA Board of Directors Approve Workers' Compensation Budget, Reinsurance, and Contributions

At the May 10 meeting the Board, approved the budget, a 7.5% increase; approved reinsurance, a 5% decrease on the \$750,000 to \$3M layer and a flat renewal on the layer to statutory limit; and approved contributions for the 2023-24 policy year that begins July 1. Contribution changes ranged from a 3.5% decrease to a 38% increase for members, based on payroll exposure and claims experience. The Board did not vote to provide a contribution discount, as they did for the 2022-23 (25%), 2021-22 (50%) and 2020-21 (50%) policy years (a 3year savings of \$9.8M to members).
