






Restoring Our Communities (ROC) Program MFA developed the ROC Program to help meet New Mexico's need for affordable housing units while assisting communities in reducing vacant and abandoned properties that reduce values within the community. \$4M in funding.

- Provide funding for acquisition and rehabilitation of vacant or abandoned properties to increase affordable housing units in New Mexico
- Create and preserve affordable housing and provide affordable housing opportunities for low-moderate- and middle-income homebuyers
- Increase home ownership opportunities up to 150% Area Media Income (AMI)
- May provide assistance in the form of zerointerest, non-amortizing, second-mortgage loan, and more
