Local Government Budget Management System

LGBMS Enhancements and New Modules are coming soon

- Security Access Form (SAF) automated process through LGBMS.
- New import report logs showing file details such as the date/time of the import and verifying all items were imported.
- Ability for local entity users to customize budget template.
- Improved system navigation and ability to filter data multiple ways.
- System notification requiring local entity users to submit supporting documentation for budget adjustment requests (BAR) that are identified as a State BAR.
- New report formats to include features such as page numbers.
- New dashboard features to include customization by users.
- Improved notifications and navigation related to comments between Local Entity users and their assigned Budget Analyst.

NEW MODULES

OUTSTANDING DEBT

- Outstanding Debt module will be available October 1, 2023.
- If your local entity budgets debt, you will be routed to a new module to enter outstanding debt details to match the budget.
- Replaces Excel outstanding debt schedule which is a required supporting budget document.

LODGERS TAX

- Lodgers Tax module will be available October 1, 2023.
- If your local entity reports Lodgers Tax data, you will be routed to a new module to enter Lodgers Tax details to match reported actuals.
- Replaces Excel Lodgers Tax report that is submitted quarterly.
