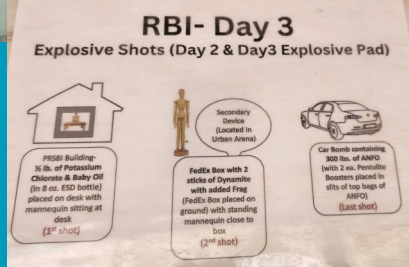

NMC Board NM Tech Explosion videos

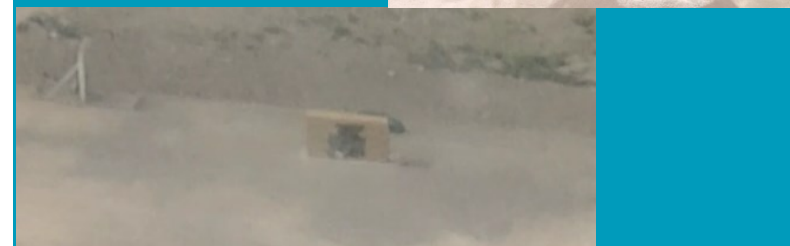
