Federal Grants

NACo supports the bipartisan [Streamlining Federal Grants Act](#), introduced last month. The bill would facilitate more straightforward grant application processes for counties.

- **Key takeaway:** The legislation tasks the Office of Management and Budget with guiding federal agencies towards streamlined grant application processes.
- **Support of Counties:** The legislation includes a special focus on aiding counties, particularly rural counties, in accessing grant opportunities.
