

#### NM HSD Tracks County-Level Data Re: Medicaid and SNAP Renewals

The <u>online data</u> renewals in your counties will be updated monthly. This measure provides a clear picture of how many individuals in your county are actively renewing their benefits as compared to the number of renewal mailings.

- Medicaid renewals received as a percent of renewals sent by county
- Percent of Medicaid renewals received over time by county
- SNAP renewals received as a percent of renewals sent by county

In Sept., the average renewal rate was 34.1%. Counties with the lowest returns include: Socorro 29.8%, Hidalgo 25.0%, Roosevelt 24.2%, Mora 23.8%, and Catron 20.0%
