

NMC: Counties Spending \$1 in Every \$3 on **Detention** NMC lobbies for state to cover more of the costs of incarceration. NM's county governments are spending increasing amounts on keeping fewer people behind bars in county jails. General Counsel Grace Philips began lobbying lawmakers on the Courts, Corrections, and Justice interim committee to increase payments

from the state to counties for jailing people. Philips stated that jail populations have gone down to 5,210 in 2022 from more than 8,5000 in 2005. For 25 counties operating jails, they spend a total of \$336.8 million on jail operations, personnel, and medical expenses at adult facilities last year out of \$1.1 billion across those counties' general funds. The estimated budget for jail operations next year is about \$383 million, more than a \$46 million dollar increase. Staff vacancy rates are 20% or greater. NMC lobbyist Katherine Crociata requested lawmakers make an appropriation of \$10 million for Detention and Corrections Workforce. Capacity Building Fund. Read more **HERE**.

Pregnant Workers Fairness Act: What Supervisors Need to Know

The Pregnant Workers Fairness Act (PWFA) became law effective June 27, 2023. Requires employers to provide reasonable accommodations to a qualified employee's or applicant's know limitation related to pregnancy, childbirth, or related medical conditions, absent undue hardship on the operation of the business of the employer.
