Santa Fe Community College's nationallyranked EPA workforce development program trains you for high-wage jobs-indemand in New Mexico. Students earn 12 industry recognized certifications in a FREE 5-week course and upon successful completion are eligible for job placement assistance from SFCC and New Mexico Department of Workforce Solutions. Starting wages for certified Environmental Technicians are \$17 to \$21 per hour.
